DESIGN, MAKE & MODEL 2019 COMPETITION

KEY DATES

Sept 1 st	Notify A&P Society of intended entry.
Sept 27th (4pm)	<u>Entries Close.</u> All entries received at the Hawke's Bay A&P Society Office. Level 2. Kenilworth Road, Hastings.
October 7 th	Final selection of garments for the showcase determined. Entrants notified.
October 19 th	All entries not selected for the showcase collected from the Hawke's Bay A&P Society Office. **Last day for blurbs to be delivered/emailed to convener
October 22 nd (4.30pm)	Catwalk practice opportunity for Open Competitors
October 23 rd (6pm)	Evening Make & Model showcase at Hawkes Bay A&P show. Final judging and prizegiving. Media photographs taken. School prize announced, all entries can be taken away at the conclusion of the Parade.

TERMS & CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- Late entries will not be accepted.
- Entry fee \$5 to be paid to the A&P society upon delivery of the items for judging.
- Categories marked OPEN SECTION (sections 1906 & 1907) are available for any member of the community to enter, including students.
- All other categories (sections 1901 – 1905) are open to any school student only.
- Each item received for judging is to be labelled on the garment with entry name, school if applicable and category entered.
- Each entry must be accompanied with colour photographs of the garment/s on the model showing a front and a back view. These photographs must also be emailed to the judges at designmakeandmodel@gmail.com. Subject line in the email is to be the Category, entrants name and school if applicable.
- All entries must be hung on a suitable hanger that will last the duration of the judging. Entries that

cannot be hung must be placed in an appropriate box, not in a bag.

- All parts of the entry form must be completed, checked and signed.
- Entries can only be entered once. Garments must not have been entered into a previous DMM show for Hawke's Bay A&P Society.
- The competition entry item must be modeled as the clear star of the ensemble ie the model must wear a plain black singlet/tshirt (If a bottom half garment is being showcased) or a plain black legging or similar for a top only garment).
- A full ensemble can also be entered.
- The Judges reserve the right not to accept a garment for judging if they feel it is not up to a reasonable standard of workmanship, finish and cleanliness.
- Competitors must construct their garments independently. Garments may only be entered into one section.
- The garment must be entirely made by the competitor- no commercially made garments will be judged.
- All categories will be included dependent on numbers and at judge's discretion and the judges decision is final.
- Prizes may not be awarded if the judges do not feel the entries are of a suitable standard in any category.
 - If a competitor is unable to attend, their garment can be modelled by someone else.

Notes for teachers:

- Teachers with students intending to enter the competition must notify the A&P society of the approximate numbers in each category no later than 1st September 2019
- Teachers must prejudge at school. If a garment is not up to an acceptable standard, please do not enter the item. No more than 10 entries per class will be accepted per category.
- Funding maybe available to assist competitors where finance is a barrier to entering. This will be assessed by the A&P Society Event Manager. Please ask events@showgroundshb.co.nz

CATEGORIES

1901: Hoodie Section (open to all school students)

1st - \$75.00 2nd - \$50.00 3rd - \$30.00

- *Design/Create a hoodie. You may use commercial patterns.*

1902: Junior Accessory (Years 7, 8 & 9)

1st - \$75.00 2nd - \$50.00 3rd - \$30.00

- *Years 7 to 9 – Make either a Bag or a cushion cover using the templates provided. Theme your item to highlight an agricultural aspect.*

1903: Junior Section (Years 9 & 10)

1st - \$75.00 2nd - \$50.00 3rd - \$30.00

- *Years 9 & 10 – Create a day wear garment/S, commercial patterns may be used.*

1904: Intermediate Section (Year 11)

1st - \$150.00 2nd - \$100.00 3rd - \$75.00

- *Create a garment/S for any occasion (including evening wear) – commercial patterns may be used.*

1905: Senior Section (Years 12 & 13)

1st - \$200.00 2nd - \$150.00 3rd - \$100.00

- *Create a garment/S for any Occasion (including evening wear) – commercial patterns may be used.*

1906: Open Designer (Open Entry)

1st - 350.00 2nd - \$150.00 3rd - \$100.00

- *Create an original outfit/ensemble consisting of up to three complimenting pieces. Any category of garment can be entered e.g. street wear, day wear, sportswear, evening wear and costumery; for men or women. You may also enter items made from recycled fabrics. Commercial patterns that have advanced adaptations may be used for example, set in sleeve altered to a puffed sleeve (not lengthening or shortening hemline). Fabric design and/or combinations showing originality and innovation are also encouraged. Students must present a Design Board/Folio of maximum 3 x A3 pages or equivalent with their entry (to show evidence of the design process, patterns and photographs of the development and progress of their garments).*

1907: Natural Fibre Design Category (Open entry)

1st - \$300.00 2nd - \$200.00 3rd - \$150.00

- *Make a garment using at least 80% natural fibre. You are encouraged in this category to make an entire ensemble. The garment may utilise commercially made fabric or you may also use crafted elements with natural fibre for example weaving, felting, knitting etc Items classed as wearable art can be entered into this category, (please note: a separate category for wearable art may be created if entry numbers allow).*

School Prize

- *A Bernina sewing machine or equivalent equipment – awarded to the school with the highest total of points awarded to prize winners. The actual prize will be confirmed on the day of the Parade.*
